extension, addition of dormer to front elevation, internal alterations, changes to fenestration and materiality. Addition of single storey double bay garage

TM/23/00928/TNCA - Ightham Mote Mote Road Ivy Hatch Sevenoaks Kent TN15 0NT G1 (applicants reference) Group of large overgrown laurel on east side of gate to south lake, between bridle way and builders yard. Low down screening becoming ineffective. - Reduce to approx 1.5-2m to allow easy maintenance and encourage leaf growth low down to improve screening. Sever ivy on large Hollies by Builders yard access gates. T2 (applicants reference) - Large, leaning Norway maple, leaning over south west Garden. - Remove section of chestnut Piling fence to gain access from bridle way. - Dismantle tree in sections to near ground level.
