**24/01642/PA** Pinewood, Pine Tree Lane, Ivy Hatch, Sevenoaks, TN15 0NJ. Conversion and alterations of existing car port and garage to form an annexe. "

**24/01599/PA** Bewley Farmhouse, Tonbridge Road, Ightham, Sevenoaks, TN15 9AP. Proposed garage replacement, front driveway and fence changes, front porch, swimming pool, facade alterations, and associated works at Bewley Farmhouse.

**24/01721/PA** - Farley Cottage, Copt Hall Road, Ightham, Sevenoaks, TN15 9DT. Removal of existing flat roof front extension. Conversion of garage to habitable room. New dormer extension to front with new entrance canopy and relocation of main entrance.
