## 9.1 PLANNING APPLICATIONS

**25/01445/PA 1 EZEL VILLAS,** BOROUGH GREEN ROAD, IGHTHAM, SEVENOAKS, TN15 9HU. Section73 Application to vary condition 2 (Approved plans) Condition 3 (Materials) Change of proposed materials from brick slate finish to zinc cladding of planning permission 25/00630/PA Removal of existing conservatory and construction of a new single storey rear/side extension.

**25/01363/PA THE PADWELL COTTAGE**, ISMAYS ROAD, IVY HATCH, SEVENOAKS, TN15 0NX. Demolition of existing dwelling and erection of a replacement self-build dwelling with associated works.

**25/01306/PA HIGH DAPPLE**, COPT HALL ROAD, IGHTHAM, SEVENOAKS, TN15 9DT. 1 x Silver Birch (applicant ref: T1 circled red on map) Reduce crown to level shown on photograph. Height from 20.5m to 15m and reshape remaining branches, and radius from 5m to 3m. Standing in Area A2 of Tree Preservation Order.

### 9.2 PLANNING DECISIONS – APPROVED

**25/00759/PA 4 AND 5 MANOR FARM COTTAGES**. Proposed single storey rear extension, additional kitchen window to side elevation and additional rooflight to existing roof.

**25/01267/PA OLDBURY HOUSE**, OLDBURY LANE. T1 Sycamore - Dismantle to near ground level and replant with a smaller ornamental, either cherry or rowan or similar.

**25/01304/PA THREE BIRCHES**, COMMON ROAD, 1 x Oak (applicants ref. T1) - Crown reduce to previous pruning points (2-3m reduction). Work is to reduce it to where it was previously pruned, maintaining it at a favourable size. Standing in Area A1 of Tree Preservation Order.

**25/01347/PA GLEBE COTTAGE**, OLDBURY LANE. 3x Oak trees (T1 - T2 - T3 applicants ref) reduce the canopy by 1-2 meters, thin out and remove epicormic growth from the stem. To maintain the shape and size of the trees and allow more light into the garden.
